The governor of Texas has declared a state of emergency in this primarily agricultural area. Over 2000 miles, or one million acres, burned. resulting in some fatalities. Over 500 houses and barns were destroyed, and 16 schools had to close because of damage. About 9000 cattle were lost, and 20 miles of power lines are down.

It will help provide food and clothing for families who have lost their homes and barns, and hay and feed for the cattle that survived.
