**The Mission of the Month (blue envelope)** is Feed the Children’s ministry in Uganda. Volunteers are working with churches there to feed about 80,000 children. They are also teaching the girls sewing and the boys carpentry skills. Uganda lacks important resources such as sanitation, access to electricity, health, education, and nutrition. Families in Uganda are often large and highly likely to fall below the poverty line. Poor health also impacts a family’s ability to work, causing poverty to be passed down through generations. Uganda has one of the youngest and most rapidly growing populations in the world, with 48% of the population under the age of 15. Currently Uganda is taking in refugees fleeing wars in its bordering neighbors of the Democratic Republic of the Congo and South Sudan.
