The August Mission of the Month (Advance) will go to help Cross Kingdom Ministries in Kerrville, Texas. This area suffered severe flooding and major loss of life a little over a year ago, and we, as a congregation, helped the families affected. Now there has been severe flooding in the Texas Hill Country again.. However, this time, because of their new advanced warning systems, they were able to evacuate hundreds of residents. Still, so far two people have lost their lives after being swept away.

Once again, our friends at Cross Kingdom Ministries have been designated as the Official Flood Relief Distribution Center. Donations go toward cleanup and rebuilding, gas and food cards, and hotels for victims of the flood, many of whom were still trying to recover from last year's flood and in the process of rebuilding their homes. You might remember, 100% of donations go to the families and individuals who need help. There are no administrative costs.

Also, this time, along with the Guadalupe, the Leona river flooded too, going right into downtown Kerrville, flooding businesses and a major highway.

If you would like to help the people of the Kerrville area who are victims of this flood, you can use the blue envelopes located in the pews in the Sanctuary.
